

BBB's February 2023 Hot Topics

1. **Multiple consumers have reported receiving fake job offers.** While the company itself is real, the job offers are not and are the work of scammers not affiliated with the company in an attempt to steal personal and financial information from victims. BBB warns consumers to be wary of unexpected job offers or interview processes that seem too easy. Review companies on BBB.org and contact the company directly if you are unsure of the legitimacy of an offer.

2. A consumer reported an attempt to buy concert tickets from a Facebook user that resulted in a scam. Once the consumer paid for the tickets via Zelle, the alleged seller cut off all contact and never sent the tickets. BBB advises consumers to only buy tickets from trusted, verified sources and to pay with credit card whenever possible.

3. A consumer needing to cancel a flight ended up losing several hundred dollars to a site not affiliated with the airline. They learned of the scam once they contacted the airline directly. BBB advises consumers to always ensure they are on an airline's website or speaking to a representative of the airline before buying, changing, or cancelling plane tickets.

4. A consumer received a call from someone impersonating the Fayette County Sheriff's office, alerting them they had failed to appear in court as a character witness. This is a scam and an attempt to scare victims into paying fake fines and/or giving out their personal information. Don't fall for it!

5. **BBB is once again receiving reports of text messages allegedly from the Indiana Department of Workforce**, regarding unemployment benefits. This is a scam message; do not click on any links or respond to the text.

6. **Scam Publishers Clearing House phone calls are on the rise again in BBB's service area.** As a reminder, the real Publisher's Clearing House only contacts winners by mail, not by phone or text. Any "sweepstakes" that claims you need to pay money upfront to claim your winnings is very likely a scam.

7. **Multiple consumers have reported online shopping scams to BBB this month**, wherein the victims never receive the ordered item or any kind of refund for a missing item. BBB reminds consumers to research companies first at <u>bbb.org</u> before ordering online, and to always pay by credit card in case you need to dispute a charge.

8. **Consumers continue to report receiving scam text messages impersonating USPS.** The texts claim a consumer's package was unable to be delivered and that the consumer needs to pay a redelivery fee. This is a scam. Do not click on any links in text messages or give out your financial information.

9. **BBB warns consumers to be on the lookout for customer service imposters.** Red flags include "representatives" who don't know any details about your account, who ask for information not needed to handle your issue (such as your Social Security Number), or who say you need to pay money to resolve your issue. Never allow anyone remote access to your device, and always contact a company directly if you need to speak to their customer service department.

10. **BBB warns consumers of fake parking ticket scams.** These scams tend to target out-of-state license plates. Before you travel, research parking options and local parking laws. If you receive a citation, examine it carefully for signs it may be fake, and always pay by credit card in case you need to dispute the charge.


